

# Hunt Oregon Gear List:

## Archery Hunts

The following is a list of essentials and nonessentials to bring on your archery hunt in Northeast Oregon in the month of September

### Essentials:

- Bow
  - Tuned to a minimum of 50lbs
- Arrows/broadheads
  - No expandable broadheads allowed on elk hunts per company rules. Deer hunts these are allowed.
- Tag/License
  - These are bought and applied for before May 15<sup>th</sup> of the year you plan on hunting with us. Please contact management for more details.
- Hiking Boots
  - Insulated or non-insulated, though there are mornings below freezing on occasion.
- Layering clothes
  - Warm and cold weather, mornings and evenings can be chilly, though mid-day will likely be over 60 degrees. Jackets, Shirts, Pants, etc.
- Raingear
  - Rain occurs on occasion, check the weather 2 days before the hunt. We routinely check weather patterns in Ukiah, OR and Pilot Rock, OR. It does not rain every year, though it can happen.
- Gloves
  - Lightweight
- Breathable Socks
  - Wool
- Sleeping bag/pillow
  - Lightweight, though the walltent will have a cot and foam pad for you to sleep on as well.
- Toiletries
  - Toothbrush/paste, Deodorant, Shower supplies, towel
- Day Pack
- Binoculars
- Hat

## Non-Essentials:

These items can be useful, but are not always necessary.

- Pack Frame
- Water Bladder
  - We have plenty of water bottles, though this may be more convenient for you.
- OnX
  - In case you get separated, so you are aware of property boundaries.
- Book/Reading material
  - Can be quite useful if you plan to utilize one of the tree stands
- Trekking Poles
- Bird Point Arrow
  - There can be quite a few grouse around, which will be legal during your hunt to harvest.
- Side Arm/Bear spray
  - We do have Mt. Lions and Bears present
- Stalking Shoes
  - Or thick bottomed socks. Are very handy during spot and stalk hunts.
- Rangefinder
  - Your guide will have one, but if you want your own this will come in handy
- Stringwax
- Face Mask
  - Camo or neutral covered, breathable is handy.
- Knife
  - Your guide will do the field dressing, though it can be handy to have a knife of your own.
- Headlamp/Flashlight
- Game Bags
